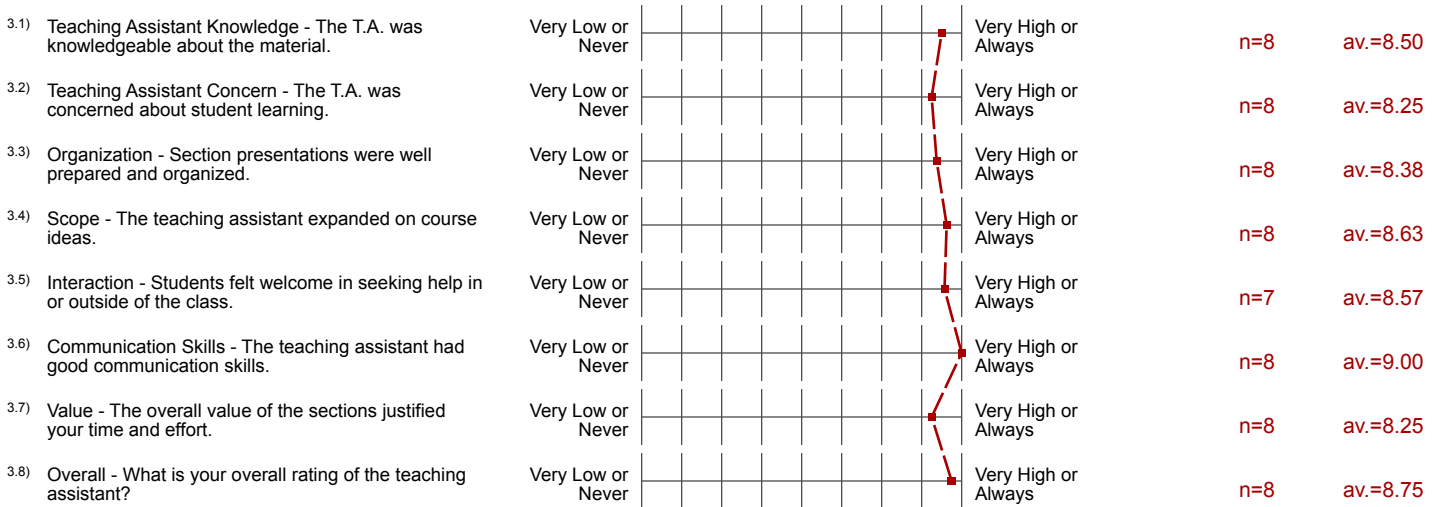
- 5.1) Please identify what you perceive to be the real strengths and weaknesses of this teaching assistant and course.

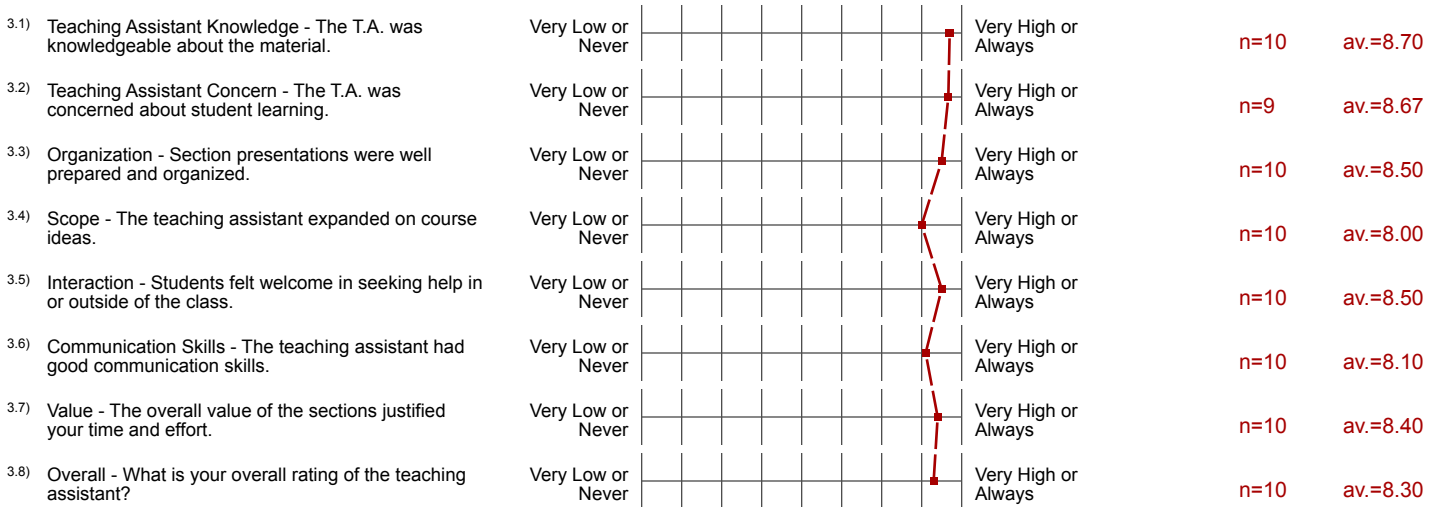
- 5.1) Please identify what you perceive to be the real strengths and weaknesses of this teaching assistant and course.

My one recommendation is to include more math examples/practice problems in the TA handouts so that we can better practice for the final exam!

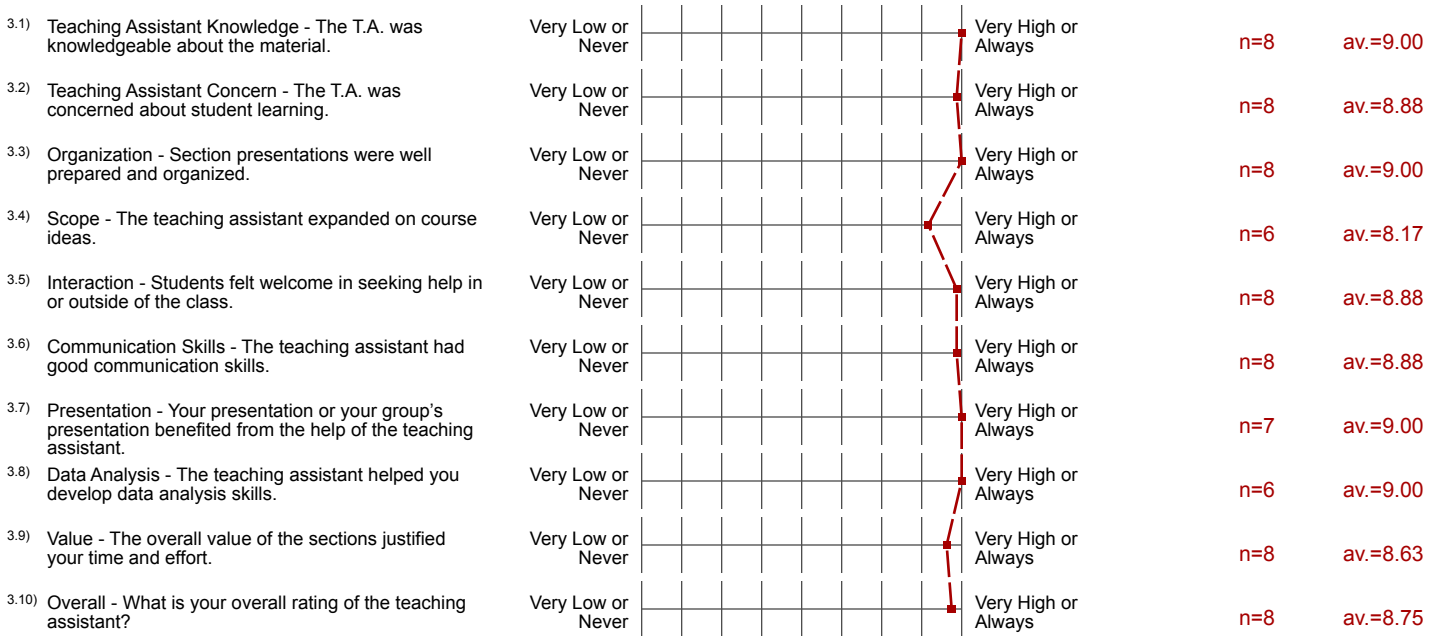

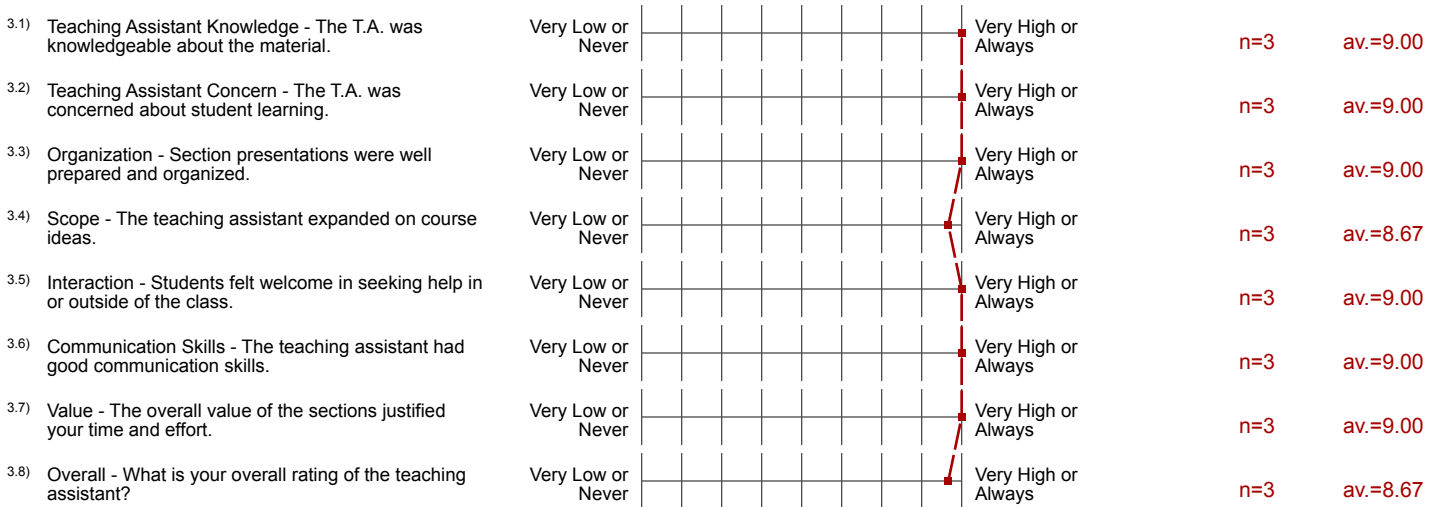
- 5.1) Please identify what you perceive to be the real strengths and weaknesses of this teaching assistant and course.
